**Prior Year Performance Level:** The level the student received in this subject on the previous year's test (LEAP, iLEAP, EOC).

**Expected Score:** Report will show the students' expected score for the current academic year.

**Student Characteristics:** Report will show many of the student characteristics taken into account when generating the expected score.

**Difference:** The point difference between the student's actual and expected scores.

**Subject Area Score:** The average of all differences between the student's actual and expected scores in a particular subject area.

**Subject Percentile:** Your subject area score, as compared to all other composite scores in that subject area. For example, a percentile of 65 is a subject area score that is higher than 65% of other teachers.

**Composite Score:** The weighted average of subject area scores for all subjects taught.

**Composite Percentile:** Your composite score, as compared to all other teachers with VAM ratings. For example, a composite percentile of 78 indicates a performance above 78% of other teachers.
